She brings a strong sense of compassion and understanding of the difficulties surrounding the euthanasia process as well as a passion in educating others on compassion fatigue. In 2019, she began lecturing at various veterinary universities on the topics of Compassion Fatigue and Improving the Euthanasia Experience.
